Question 1

- Do IXPs make the Internet faster?

Question 2

- What does “faster” mean?
 - End user consumers have different view from a science researcher doing mass data transfers, who have different view from travellers/remote users
 - And what is the IXP’s relevance in all of this?

Question 3

- What does “IXP” mean?
 - Local vs regional vs international – different models, different functions, different businesses

Question 4

- Content providers view of the world is delivering content to their “eye-balls” with low latency and high quality
